



Invitation to participate in the 2013 Student Poster Competition in Medicinal and Biomolecular Chemistry

The Biomolecular Division and the South Australia Branch of the Royal Australian Chemical Institute are organising a Student Poster Competition to be held at 4 pm on **Monday 8th April 2013** at Bionomics in Thebarton.

Students from South Australia are invited to submit poster abstracts on research in an area of biomolecular or medicinal chemistry and directly (chemistry) related disciplines. If selected, they will present their poster at the local meeting, where the posters will be judged.

The winner of the best student poster will receive a prize of free registration for the Division of Biomolecular Chemistry Conference, 14-17th July 2013, Blue Mountains, NSW. The winner will be invited to present their research as a poster at the conference.

Eligibility criteria:

- South Australian resident enrolled as a **student** at the time of poster entry.
- Student member or member of the Royal Australian Chemical Institute at the time of poster entry.

Abstract format and submission:

Abstracts should contain a title, author(s), and affiliation(s), as well as text. Figures, tables and references are allowed, as long as the total abstract fits on one A4 page.

Abstracts should be submitted as a pdf, with the name of the presenter as the file name, to one of the following university representatives:
