Plenary Speakers

Internationally renowned people—Nobel Prize winners, CEOs of big companies etc. of interest to a broad spectrum of people. We would have to cover all costs for these people and I would suggest be inviting them in the next 6-12 months. To identify these speakers all symposia chairs will be asked for input and will vote on the nominated list. A strong line up of speakers here is critical to the success of the meeting.

Invited Speakers

High profile speakers invited for a given symposium or perhaps two or three symposia. The congress would probably cover registration. Each symposium would nominate these speakers but sharing would make the meeting stronger.

Contributed Talks/Posters

The normal contributions from people who wish to come. Symposium chairs would have to organise individual programs giving people talks/posters.
