

RACI Women in Materials Chemistry promotion Program

To encourage more female students and female ECRs to attend Materials Chemistry Conference for research exchange and networking, MC division developed a special program to promote women involving in the Materials Chemistry community under the umbrella of the ARC Georgina Sweet Australian Laureate Fellowship program. Several financial support will be provided to the awardees, in terms of the merit-based assessment conducted by a defined selection committee, composed of several senior academic staff, including female staff.

Selection Criteria:

1. The applicants must be current female postgraduate students or ECRs (<10ys after received PhD degree)
2. Being RACI members (ECRs-for at least 9 months prior to application), interested in MCD.
3. The applicants must submit the abstract to the RACI Congress 2022-MC symposium for oral presentations (ECR/HDR) or poster (HDR only).

Offer:

1. Up to 3 Female ECRs (\$1095 each)
2. Up to 3 HDR students (\$545 each)
3. Priority for oral presentation

Reimbursement based on invoice +report (see below) after conference

Post-Award:

1. Provide a report on the rewarding and experience after conference (1 page with one photo)
2. Willingness to talk a women event (organized by the division) to share the experience (within 6 months)
3. Join MC division and MC women network.

Application requirements:

1. A CV, including a publication list
2. A copy of the abstract submitted to the Congress organisers
3. A short rationale on why you should be accepted
4. Email your application to Materials@raci.org.au (with subject- Women in Materials Chemistry)
